

Dear Parents,

Thank you for registering your child at the Nagel Jewish Academy at Beverly Hills. We have planned a fun-filled year of Torah learning.

The Nagel Jewish Academy is a place where the joys, values, and traditions of Judaism are brought to life. We focus on the beauty and significance of our heritage through discussions, workshops, and hands-on projects. We emphasize Jewish values and ethics. The goal of our school is to instill the feeling of pride and affection for our heritage and to inspire the natural curiosity of our students. We believe this can best be accomplished in an atmosphere of joy and warmth.

Classes will take place Monday- Thursday from 3:00pm-5:00pm. We require students to attend a minimum of three days a week.

There is NO AFTERCARE. Any parents who arrive more than 15 minutes after dismissal will be charged \$10 PER 5 MINUTES. We will charge your credit card on file the following morning.

The classes are structured in a way that will maximize learning opportunities for all our students. Therefore, the classes are divided as follows:

Kita Aleph- 5 year olds

Kita Bet- 6 & 7 year olds

Kita Gimmel- 8 & 9 year olds

Kita Dalet- 10, 11 & 12 year olds

Pick-up and Drop-Off:

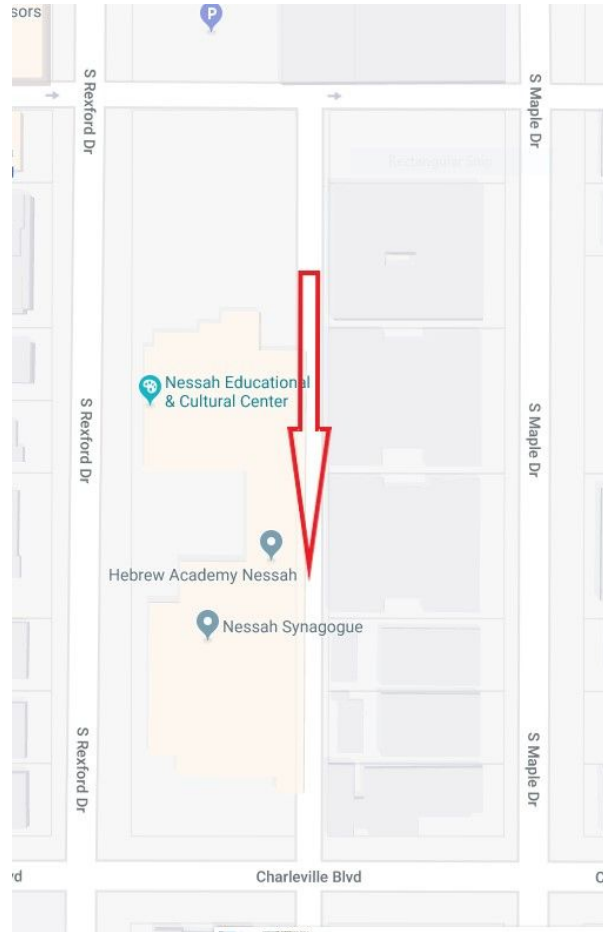
Drop off begins 15 minutes before school starts, and ends 15 minutes after school ends.

If you arrive after drop-off, please park your car and walk your child into his/her classroom.

Drop-off is in the alley behind Nessah Synagogue, and students should enter through the open door.

We ask for a North to South traffic flow.

Attendance:

The teachers will take attendance everyday.

Discipline Policy:
